

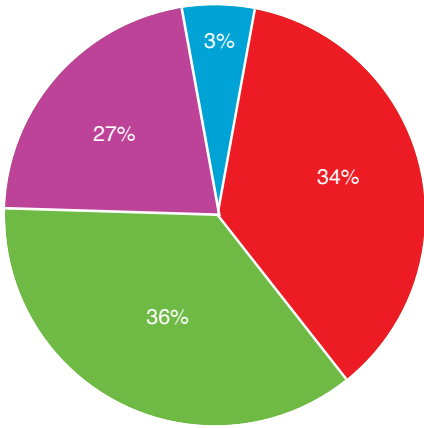
Who We Serve

One in every 10 children in North Dakota will be a victim of sexual abuse by their 18th birthday; approximately 65% will be female. Based on data from the CDC, a conservative estimate for the cost of maltreatment in North Dakota was more than \$525 million in one year.

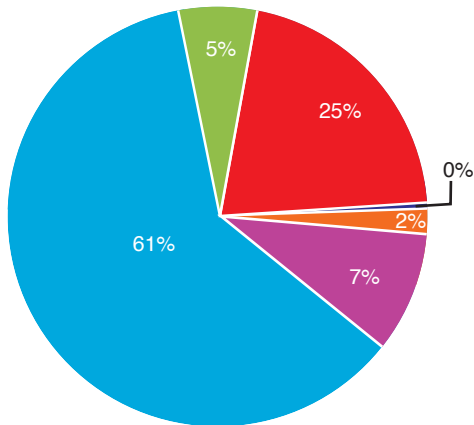

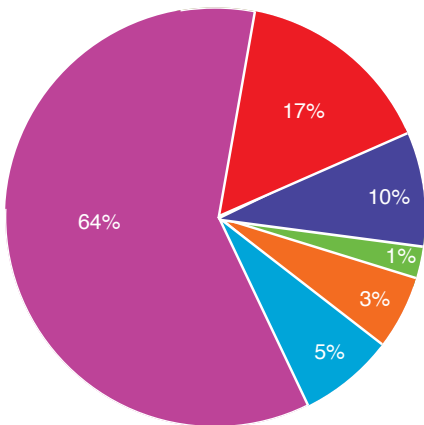
Though abuse affects children of all ages, the majority of children seen at Children's Advocacy Centers in North Dakota are under 12.

Survivors of Abuse and Neglect

The majority of cases seen at the CACs in North Dakota involve an allegation of sexual abuse. In fact, more than one in ten of all substantiated victim abuse and neglect referrals to social service agencies nationwide are victims of sexual abuse.
